





4333, balanced.

15hcp

141/2Pts

+½Pt Honour 10C

(No honour singletons, Not aceless, Not isolated honours.)

### So what to Open?

It is up to individual style.

If you consider the 141/2 as 14Pts, open 1NT (12..14Pts).

If you consider the 141/2 as 15Pts, open 1S, planning a 1NT rebid.

### Week 14 Session Plan

Opener bids 1:OSuit with 12..19 evaluated points

When Responder has a fit with a Major OSuit, he raises depending upon his evaluated point count, hcp and shape. (6..9; 10..12; 13+).

When Responder has no immediate fit, further suits can be bid to investigate them. Generally bidding low until a fit is found.

If no fit is found, or if the fit is a Minor Suit, usually a No Trump contract is preferred.

So we will look at the basic bids.

We will also look at:

No Trump bids later in the auction tend to be when a Major suit fit cannot be found. Depending upon the specifics of each hand, it is common to want to play a Minor suit fit in NT as the score for "n" tricks is much better in NT than ♣ or ◆. With enough points for Game, 3NT is frequently easier than 5Minor.

No Trumps can also happen if Opener has a balanced hand & 15+Pts.

### **Play**

Play as if "Duplicate Pairs".

{NS} have the pair number of their table, {N} has his back to the stage. {EW} have the pair number of their table plus 8.

Play boards in sequence. Have an incoming pile and an outgoing pile. Pass outgoing to next lower numbered table – Table 1 to highest table.

Some boards have instructions on card. The appropriate people should read each card at the time it says and follow its instructions.

If you play a board twice, record the second play on the traveller using your pair numbers PLUS TEN (eg 1 v 9 becomes 11 v 19)

If you wish to fill in a personal results card, they are available here. They are commonly used at duplicate clubs.

Don't forget to describe partner's bids and plays to the table.

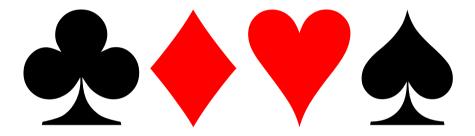


