What was the contract **and the result**? Write it in the contract column.

Who was declarer? Write N S E or W in the "by" column.

IGNORE THE LEAD COLUMN for u3aib, **just get the rest correct**.

How many tricks did declarer make? Write 0 .. 13 in Tricks column.

What was the score? Write a positive number in the relevant column:

If NS got the points, use NS or NS+ column.

If EW got the points, use EW or NS- column.

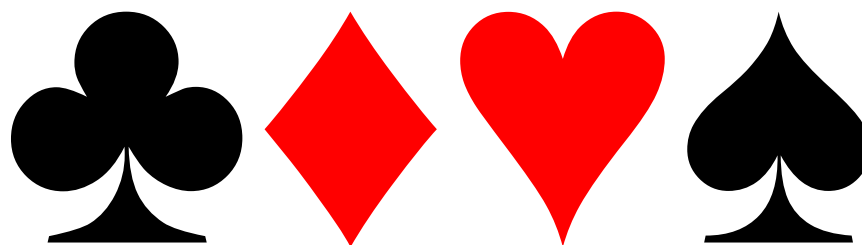
And all FOUR travellers per board should be IDENTICAL.

There are various levels of explanation:

- 12..19, L4+X
- 12..19, L4+X or rule of 20 (9..11 HCP, HCP + LX + LY more or equal to 20)
- With a balanced hand (4333, 4432 (not ♠), 5332), 15..19 HCP.
Check system card to see if L5X is opened as X or NT.

With unbalanced hand, 12..19 Points. If 11- HCP, meet both 12..19 Points and Rule of 20.

With 4441 shape, 14..19 HCP for ♥, not ♠.

Week 13 Major Suit Trial Bids

Partner follows suit

1X 12..19, L4+X or rule of 20

1♥ (-) 2♥ 6..9 HCP balanced, 6..9 Points unbalanced, L4+X

1♠ (-) 2♠ Therefore a joint 18..28 Point Fit.
(Occasionally L3X if nothing else better than 1NT)

Andrew Robson says

"The guideline is to raise to 2♥/♠ with three cards in preference to responding the dustbin 1NT, unless you have both a very flat hand (eg 4333) and three small cards."

- A Trial bid says that game is possible, but if the reply comes back "I can't help" from Partner, the pair play in 3X.

In which case (3X) they need 23 Points jointly. As partner may have only 6 Points, Opener needs to have 17..18 to consider a major game.

*Note these are **Points**, not **HCP**. Include length and, now a fit is found, shortage points.*

Major Suit Trial Bids and related other bids. *(Slide edited post session)*

1X (-) 2X (-) 3Y (or 2♠) Game possible, Can you help with Y?

"I am weak in suit Y" defined:

A WEAK suit Y is one with **L3+Y** and 2 or 3 losers **and NOT 2+ winners**.

SGB added the bit in blue above to assist with trying to get the algorithm right.

- Jxx L3, 3 losers Jxx, WEAK
- Axxx L4, 3 losers xxx, WEAK
- AQxx L4, 3 losers Qxx, WEAK
- AQx L3, 2 losers Qx, *SGB reckons this is therefore WEAK*

- Ax L2, so NOT weak (as it happens only 1 loser x)
- xx L2, so NOT weak (as it happens 2 losers xx)
- KQJx L4, 2 losers Kx, **but 2 winners, NOT weak**
- AKxx L4, 2 losers xx, **but 2 winners, NOT weak**

Some of these examples are by SGB and are not expert validated.

"I can / can't help with suit Y" defined:

Three options for Responder after call for help with Y:

The number of losers is only for suit Y.

(a) 0..1 Y losers

(or 2+ winners)

0: A

0: void

1: Ax

2: KQJx, 2 losers (Kx), **but also** 2 winners (QJ)

Bid game, **4X**, even with only 6 Points.

(b) 2 Y losers

Judge hand and choose between (c) and (a).

Generally with 6..7 Points, choose (c),

and with 8..9 Points, choose (a).

(c) 3+ Y losers

Signoff in **3X**, the lowest level.

23 Points should be ok for this.

Week 13 Play

Play

NS have the pair number of their table, N has his back to the stage.
EW have the pair number of their table plus 8.

Play boards in sequence. Have an incoming pile and an outgoing pile. Pass outgoing to next lower numbered table – Table 1 to highest table.

Many boards have instructions on coloured card. **The appropriate people should read each card at the time it says and follow its instructions.**

If you play a board twice, record second play on traveller with pair numbers PLUS TEN (eg 1 v 9 becomes 11 v 19)

As part of the learning process – I would like the partner of whoever has just bid to take whatever action is **standardly required** (eg announcing 1NT to be 12-14 points, ALERTing a conventional bid, ...) – **AND ALSO** to give a brief **description** to the other three players on what the bid means.

If you wish to fill in a personal results card, they are available here. They are commonly used at duplicate clubs.

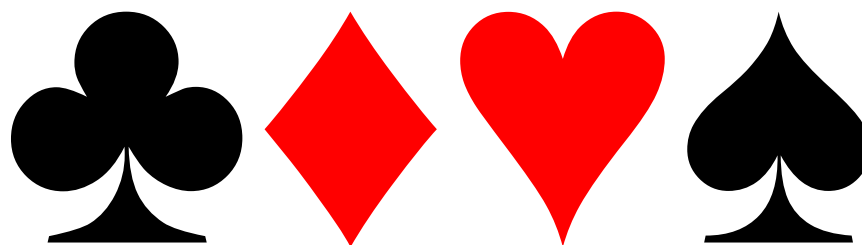

Boards as played are rotated compared to the book presentation (which mostly make South dealer). Rotation defined by position of A♠.

Each board had a card defining what bidding was expected. Tables were inviting to play with their bidding, or the expected bidding or both.

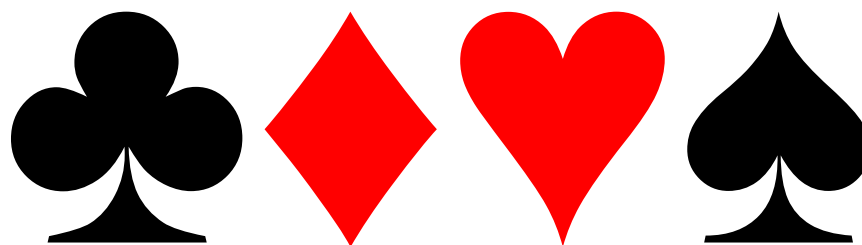
