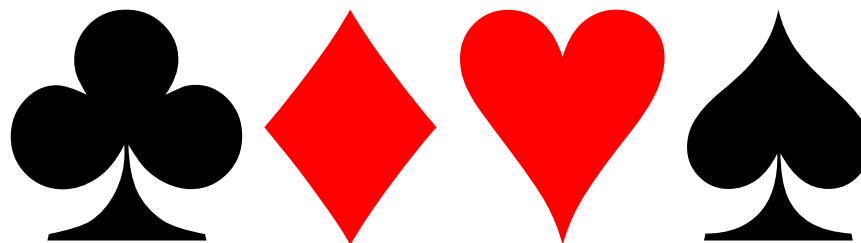

## Week 2 Weak Overcall Response

Some of you said that you haven't learnt "**Bidding to the Level of the Fit**".

Reference: RWPB Chapter 9. In particular pages 94/95.

There are two reasons for overcalls. One is because you have a genuine competitive bid. The other is to be obstructive and stop your opponents finding their correct contract.

**ALL BIDS SUPPORTING PARTNER'S OVERCALL ARE WEAK.**

Experts have found that bidding to make the same number of tricks that you have trumps frequently works. *As always, none of these guidelines apply 100% of the time.* Consider your hand weak with 0..9 Pts.

Note that the weaker you are, the stronger your opponents will be and the more necessary it is for you to be obstructive.

## Week 2 Weak Overcall Response

### Bidding to the Level of the Fit

Bid to the level of the fit (*if bidding too high, just pass*):

with L2, pass (5+2 = 7, a 1suit bid, already done.)

with L3, bid 2suit (5+3 = 8, a 2suit bid)

with L4, bid 3suit (5+4 = 9, a 3suit bid)

with L5, bid 4suit (5+5 = 10, a 4suit bid)

Partner's overcall showed L5+suit. With L6, he can raise your response 1 level to be obstructive if necessary.

Do not pass because you have few points.

Your bid is telling partner the EXACT number of cards in that suit in your hand and that you are WEAK.

*Should you happen to be strong, use an Unassuming Cue Bid, a No Trump bid, or Change Suit.*

The scores in green are what would have been obtained had the U3A club contract had been made. Table 1 NS would still have been a bottom. Table 5 a near top – but is it achievable?



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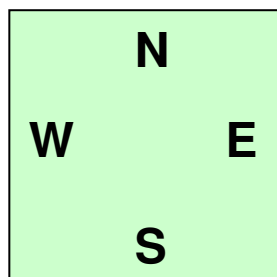

Spades is a major and is less balanced (5-3 not 4-4), the 432 will be very valuable ruffing Hearts. Add 5 points for a void after the fit in partner's Spades. 24 Pts.

That is actually enough to start contemplating slams, but agree Spades first. (4♠ would be shut out).

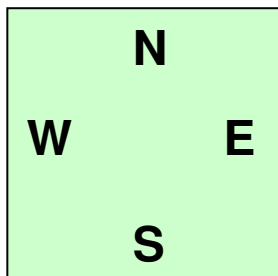

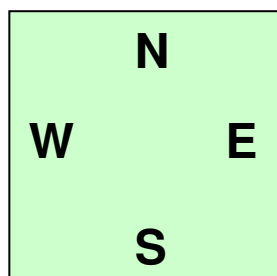

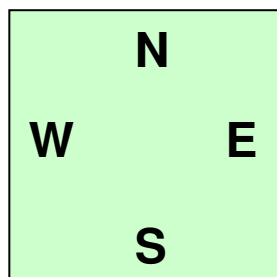

You can't use Blackwood with a void. Cue bidding is the way to go, but if not, then Pass, Pass, Pass.

E to lead to 4S.



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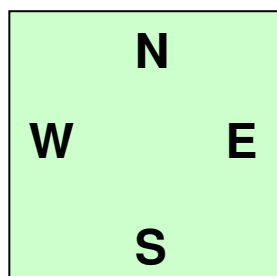

**As part of the learning process** – I would like the partner of whoever has just bid to take whatever action is **standardly required** (eg announcing 1NT to be 12-14 points, ALERTing a conventional bid, ...) – **AND ALSO** to give a brief **description** to the other three players on what the bid means.

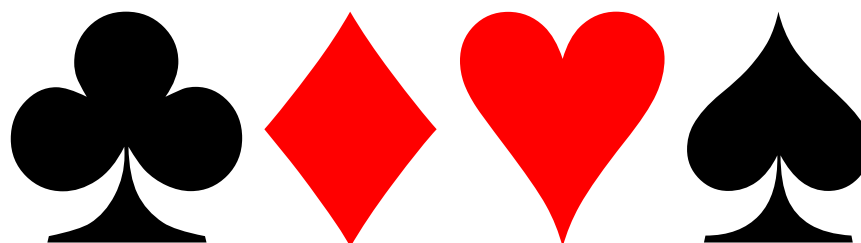
