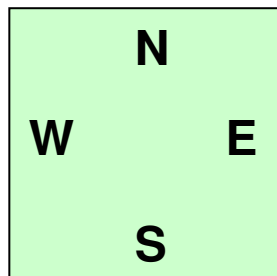

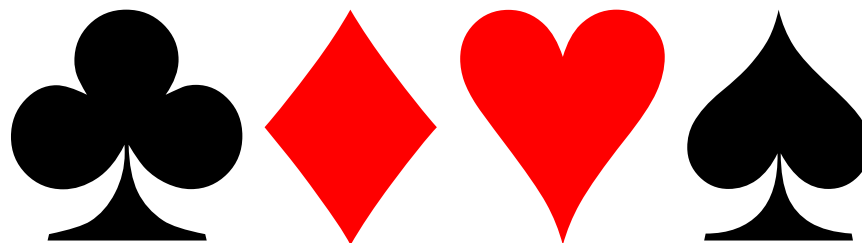

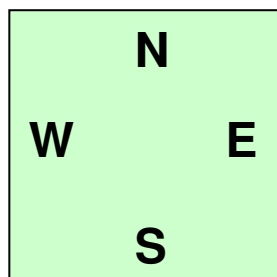

### **"From The Beginning"**

With some folk having had an 18 month "holiday" from bridge due to the lockdowns, I have had several requests to reprise Bridge from the beginning.

Also, I want to bring U3AIB's standard play to a more modern position.

And on top of that, I am endeavouring to create a U3AIB Cribsheet in the style of the No Fear Bridge Cribsheet that includes Transfers and Benjaminised Acol.

So this week we look at opening bidding with balanced hands.

Tens                      +1/3 only when the 10 is an honour (With AKQJ9).

Nines                      +1/6 only when the 9 accompanies the 10.

*Experts tend to say +1/2 but only for the first two Tens. An accompanying Nine may make a hand "good".*

*I prefer the numerical scheme above, where 3 Tens make +1 Point.*

*Also Ten with accompanying Nine makes +1/2 Point.*

*So although this may look complicated, the numbers add together easily.*

And though only relevant to suited contracts, once a fit has been found include shortage points - discussed another week when we are looking at suits.

*This is a "Weak NT". Some people use a "Strong NT (15..17 or 16..18). Yet others use a "variable NT" where the scheme depends upon the vulnerability.*

12..14 5332 with L5Major

has experts using 3 different schemes.

- i) Always open 1NT
- ii) Always open 1Major
- iii) Open 1 Major if the L5Major is "good enough" to be rebiddable at the 2-level.

(iii) is recommended for both Old and Modern Acol.

Eg: 1H (-) 1S (-) // 1NT is a raise in NT.

Eg: 1H (-) 2C (-) // 2NT is a raise in NT.

The difference in the level reached is handled by responder's strength when he chooses to bid at the 2-level.

With a 4432 shaped hand, you have TWO longest suits.  
*This is discussed later.*

*Which longest suit?*

With 4432 shape, there are two longest suits. U3AIB used to recommend "Right Way to Play Bridge"'s scheme. I now recommend Bernard Magee's one.

#### RWPB Acol

Bid H if you have it.

Bid a minor otherwise and the weaker if both minors.

#### Modern Plain Acol

Bid Higher ranking suit except:

Bid H if both majors (S & H)

Bid C if both minors (D & C).

*Most other experts appear to advise:*

*The higher ranking, except H if both S & H.*

Don't forget how the **STOP** card works: Use it for every JUMP bid.

- Decide your bid.
- Place the **STOP** card on the table:
  - This attracts the attention of the other players and FORBIDS the next player from bidding.
- Then immediately make your bid - no hesitation.
- Then wait 10 seconds whilst the rest of the table ponders the significance of your jump bid.
- Then put the **STOP** card back in your bidding box so that bidding can continue.

Experts all differ in the ranges they recommend for NT with Benji. The ranges presented here are of my choosing.

Both Plain and Benji Acol use their version of the superstrong bid to show a balanced hand of 23+ Points. 23 Points should be enough to make 2NT.

When using Benji, the meaning of 2C changes. If you use Benji for suit bidding but the Plain Acol for strong hand NT bidding, you will have [ 2C 2D ] mean one point range if followed by a suit and another range if followed by 2NT/3NT. *It works, but be aware.*

## Week 2 Play

### Play

NS have the pair number of their table, N has his back to the stage.  
EW have the pair number of their table plus 8.

Play boards in sequence. Have an incoming pile and an outgoing pile. Pass outgoing to next **lower** numbered table – Table 1 to highest table.

Many boards have instructions on coloured card. **The appropriate people should read each card at the time it says and follow its instructions.**

**If you play a board twice, record second play on traveller with pair numbers PLUS TEN (eg 1 v 9 becomes 11 v 19)**

**As part of the learning process** – I would like the partner of whoever has just bid to take whatever action is **standardly required** (eg announcing 1NT to be 12-14 points, ALERTing a conventional bid, ...) – **AND ALSO** to give a brief **description** to the other three players on what the bid means.

*If you wish to fill in a personal results card, they are available here. They are commonly used at duplicate clubs.*

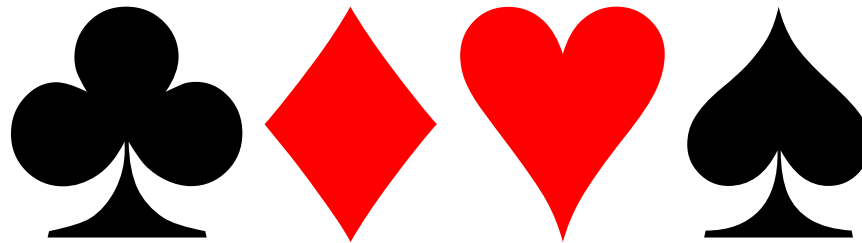

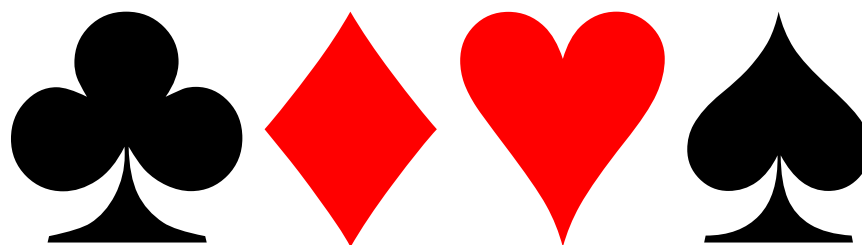
