

Week 16 Hand Evaluation Revision

Hand evaluation revision

Different folk do evaluation differently. This is "rule based", but some folk use a more "intuitive" scheme. And the rules could differ.

hcp Ace=4 King=3 Queen=2 Jack=1.

(high card But a singleton K Q J is only worth half

points) King=1½ Queen=1 Jack=½.

An honour Ten is worth ½, but only up to two of them.

An honour 10 is a 10 in the same suit as an A K Q J or 9.

Length Add 1 evaluated Point (Point) for every card in a suit

longer than 4. So L5S is worth +1, L7H is worth +3.

But if the suit is particularly poor (head by zero

honours, or maybe just a Jack or a Ten with the

other cards being small, reduce the addition.

Shape Subtract 1 Point for a 4333 shape.

Aceless Subtract 1 Point for a Aceless hand

Isolated honours Subtract 1 if no suit has 2+ honours when the

hand has 6+hcp.

Hand evaluation revision

Re-evaluate the hand when the bidding alters something. Finding a Fit requires a re-evaluation.

Shortages

In the long trump hand (the hand that first naturally names the suit).

Add 3 for a void, 2 for a singleton, 1 for a doubleton.

In the short trump hand (the partner's hand).

Add 5 for a void, 3 for a singleton, 1 for a doubleton.

Rules and Choice

All these "rules" are intended to assist working out how much a hand is worth. Sometimes you may get "conflicts". For example: A hand worth 6..9hcp may evaluate as 10Pts and a **choice** has to be made about which level to respond at.

As you get more experience you will learn when, and which, "rules" should be ignored or modified.

Showing Preference.

With a weak hand, Responder may not wish to bid on to Game and chooses one of Opener's two bid suits. Responder signs off in Opener's first suit OSuit1 unless OSuit2 is longer by 2 or more (when he bids Pass).

Eg: 1C 1H 1S 2C (S is not 2+ longer than C)

or: 1C 1H 1S Pass (S is 2+ longer than C)



Week 16 Play

Play

Play as if "Duplicate Pairs".

{NS} have the pair number of their table, {N} has his back to the stage. {EW} have the pair number of their table plus 8.

Play boards in sequence. Have an incoming pile and an outgoing pile. Pass outgoing to next lower numbered table – Table 1 to highest table.

Some boards have instructions on card. The appropriate people should read each card at the time it says and follow its instructions.

If you play a board twice, record the second play on the traveller using your pair numbers PLUS TEN (eg 1 v 9 becomes 11 v 19)

If you wish to fill in a personal results card, they are available here. They are commonly used at duplicate clubs.

Don't forget to describe partner's bids and plays to the table.




