

While waiting for 10am – Week 11

How do you win 5 tricks in this suit in a NT contract?

There are no outside entries for cross-overs.

{EW} are only missing H:J743.

There is no problem if the missing cards split 2:2 or 3:1. The H:KAQ will draw them and H:T6 will remain as master. So win the first trick in the hand with **two** masters to see if/where a 4:0 split exists.

First consider {N} having L4H.

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When {N} has L4H.

And when {S} has L4H.

{W} {**N**} {S} {E} Win first trick in the hand with two masters ({W} H:KQ) to check split. Lead KS or 2S>KS. Assume {N} plays his lowest H. {S} discards. **♥ K**QT65 discard **♥** A98**2 ♥** J74**3** Cross to {E} using AH. **♥** QT6**5 ♥ A**98 **♥** J7**4** Then run 8H unless JH played when win with QH. **♥** QT6 **98 ♥** J**7** Run 8H **♥ J** QH beats JH ♥ QT ♥ Win 10H Or if {S} plays JH at trick 3. **♥ Q**T6 **98 ♥ J**7 QH beats JH **▼ T**6 **▼ 7** Win 10H ♥ Win 6H

So all possible situations can be managed.

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Week 10 Slams

For a Small No Trump slam, 6NT, you want 33+hcp.

Nominally that is "all 40 hcp except for an AK".

As long as the missing Ace and King are in different suits, you can reasonably hope to lose to the missing Ace but to beat the missing King with your Ace.

For a grand No Trump slam, 7NT, you want 37+hcp.

Nominally that is "all 40 hcp except for a K".

You can reasonably hope to beat the missing King with your Ace.

Just determine your Joint Pointcount and bid appropriately.

If the JPt range **may** meet the threshold ask.

Ask using the next "spare" NT bid up.

If the JPt range meets the next threshold, just bid it.



Week 11 NT Thresholds

The three thresholds are

25Pts for a Game

Ask with 2NT. Respond Pass or 3NT.

Bid 3NT.

33Pts for a Small slam

Ask with 4NT. Respond Pass or 6NT.

Bid 6NT.

37Pts for a Grand slam

Ask with 5NT. Respond 6NT or 7NT.

Bid 7NT.

After the opening lead is made and dummy is visible, Declarer should make a plan with ATTITWDE.

A Aim Decide what you want to achieve - it will not always be "the contract".

In **Duplicate Teams** bridge it will be "make the contract" with little interest in overtricks - especially not any that could go wrong.

In **Duplicate Pairs** bridge, it will be "get the highest score". Overtricks are worth taking risks for. Sometimes a sacrificial bid will get a better score for you \sim Eg your 3Dx-1 = -100 compared to their 2H \checkmark = -110 (or if they bid on to 3H-1 = +50) \sim all as seen from your POV.

After the opening lead is made and dummy is visible, Declarer should make a plan with ATTITWDE.

TT Top Tricks Count TT: A or AK or AKQ or AKQJ etc.

Determine what you can make "regardless". Obviously these Top Tricks could be ruffed in a suit contract, but "plan" to avoid that.

But this assumes that you draw all the missing cards before playing your small cards. You have to play the cards in the right order.

After the opening lead is made and dummy is visible, Declarer should make a plan with ATTITWDE.

Increase Tricks (I use XT eXtra Tricks.) Work out how and what may get XT.

Typically you can get eXtra Tricks using some of:

Force / High Cards

◆ KJ8
◆ Q7 Lose QD→AD, Win D:KJ [2][-1]

Length

♣ KQ6432 **♣** J7 Lose JC→AC, [-1]

Win C:KQ as high cards, [2]

if split was 3:2, C:AT985 are drawn and

C:643 are length winners [3]

Technique

Finesse, Deep finesse, Squeeze, Endplay etc.

♠ 84 Finesse QS, 50% unless "info" [½][-½]

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Week 11 Making a Plan in No Trumps

After the opening lead is made and dummy is visible, Declarer should make a plan with ATTITWDE.

WD Worry about Defence What can go wrong.

Can the Defenders "hold up" playing their high card by ducking and cut your hands off from each other?

What if the Defenders have an unbalanced split?

Eg not 3:2 but 4:1 or even 5:0?

Will that adversely affect your length tricks?

Entries/Execution How to go about making your XT.

To establish tricks in a long suit, you often have to lose tricks (or in a suited contract, ruff in the other hand).

You need an entry for each loss and one more entry to take the winners.

Week 11 Play

Play

Play as if "Duplicate Pairs".

{NS} have the pair number of their table, {N} has his back to the stage. {EW} have the pair number of their table plus 8.

Play boards in sequence. Have an incoming pile and an outgoing pile. Pass outgoing to next lower numbered table – Table 1 to highest table.

Some boards have instructions on card. The appropriate people should read each card at the time it says and follow its instructions.

If you play a board twice, record the second play on the traveller using your pair numbers PLUS TEN (eg 1 v 9 becomes 11 v 19)

If you wish to fill in a personal results card, they are available here. They are commonly used at duplicate clubs.

Don't forget to describe partner's bids and plays to the table.



Week 11 Set hands

Set hand abbreviations

Bd Board Number of the board. Rarely may include a colour!

Eg 5red or 5blue.

Dlr Dealer (NESW).

Vul Vulnerability (None NS EW All).

Rotn Rotation Defined by one card, usually A♠.

Mostly different to source publication.

Dcl Declarer (NESW)

OL Opening Lead

Trk Tricks (0..13)

NS# EW# Score for NS or EW

NS% EW% Percentage of NS and EW

Ref Reference result (Sometimes there may be more than one)

Blue results as played.

Red results are reference results.


